Funerals	Up to 100 — or 1 per 2m ² — or 100% seated and ticketed	
Commercial residential facilities like hostels etc	1 per 4m ² sleeping areas, 1 per 2m ² common areas	3 per 4m ²
Indoor play areas	COVID Safe Checklist	3 per 4m ² New checklist
Dancing	1 per 2m ²	3 per 4m ² New checklist
Self-service food	Not allowed to open	No restrictions
Gatherings	100 at homes	No limit but keep attendance list over 100
Indoor events	500 people with COVID Safe Checklist Larger events require a COVID Safe Plan	3 per 4m ² — or 100% seated and ticketed New checklist
Ticketed venues	100% capacity with allocated seating Performers 2m from audience Choirs 4m from audience Patrons encouraged to wear masks on entry and exit	
Open air stadiums and other large event venues etc.	COVID Safe Plan	Still need COVID Safe Plan
Check In Qld app	Mandatory for hospitality sector – 1 May 2021	Mandatory for new sectors – 9 July 2021
